

# SYSWINDOWS command

The **SYSWINDOWS** command is used to arrange windows and icons when application program sharing a window with external application program.

## Command Access:

**Ribbon** : View > User Interface > Tile Horizontally

**Menu** : Window > Tile Horizontally

**Command** : SYSWINDOWS

## Command Prompts:

Enter an option [Cascade/tile Horizontal/ tile Vertical/Arrange icons]:

## Relative Glossary:

### **Cascade:**

Arrange a lot of windows for easily visiting by windows cascade.

### **Tile Horizontal:**

Arrange open drawings in horizontal and non-overlapping pattern. Users could check drawings by line. If out of space, it will add other columns to arrange windows.

### **Tile Vertical:**

Arrange open windows in vertical non-overlapping pattern. Users could check drawings by column. If out of space, it will add other lines to arrange windows.

### **Arrange icons:**

Arrange window icons.

Minimize the drawing and display open drawings on the bottom of drawing area.
