
## Use a Template File to Start a Drawing

You can use a drawing template file, which contains standard settings. Drawing template files have a .dwt file extension. You can choose one of the supplied template files or you can create your own templates.



## Create a Drawing Template File

If you want to use the same default settings and conventions to create several drawings, it will save time by creating or customize a template file. Template files are stored in the template folder by default.

## Recover the Default Drawing Template File

If the original default settings of the drawing template file gcad .dwt or gcadiso .dwt have been changed, you can make a reset. Start a new drawing without a template and save it as a template, replacing gcad

.dwt or gcadiso .dwt. You can also use  $\underline{\text{NEW}}$  to display the Select Template dialog box.
