


## Filter Selection Sets



You can use object properties or object types to include or exclude objects in or from a selection set.

If you want to filter selection sets by property (like color) and by object type, you can use Quick Select ([QSELECT](#)) from the Properties palette ([PROPERTIES](#)) or the Object Selection Filters dialog box

([FILTER](#)). You can name and save filters for future use with object selection filters.





If you want to filter your selection set based on [COLOR](#) , [LINETYPE](#) or lineweight ([LWEIGHT](#)), first consider whether these properties are set BYLAYER for any objects. If a circle's color is set to BYLAYER and the layer color is red, it can not be select by filter based on red color.
