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To correct or repeat commands, you can edit text in the command window. Using the standard keys: UP, DOWN, HOME, END and BACKSPACE.

Any command used in the current session can be repeated. You can cycle through the commands in the command window using the UP and DOWN ARROW and repeat it by pressing ENTER.

A shortcut menu is displayed, when you right-click in the command or text window, from which you can access the five most recently used commands.

For most commands, a command line with two or three lines of previous prompts, called the command history. To see more command history, you can scroll through the history or resize the command window by dragging its border. You can press F2 to use the text window when you need a larger command window. For example ,when you enter the commands with text output, such as LIST.
