To Work With Path Arrays

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Show how to create and edit path arrays.

To Create a Path Array

1. Do one of the followings:

- Select Modify > Array > Path Array on the main menu.
- Click the Path Array tool on the Array toolbar.
- Type ARRAYPATH and press Enter.

2. Select the objects to array and press Enter.
3. Select path curve.
4. Move the cursor along the path curve to make adjustments.
5. Press Enter to complete the array.

To Specify the Distance Between Objects Arrayed on a Path

1. Select an item in the array.
2. Click Array > Items > Between.
3. Enter a distance.

Fill in Arrayed Objects After the Path Length Changes

1. Select an item in the array.
2. In the Properties palette, under Misc, make sure the Method setting equals Measure.
3. In the Fill entire path box, click Yes.

Adjust the Spacing Between Items in a Path Array

1. Select an item in the array.
2. In the Properties palette, set the Method property to Measure.
3. Click the Item spacing grip. When there are three or more items in the array, this grip displays on the second item in the first row of the path array.
4. Move the cursor along the path to increase or decrease the distance between the items and then click.
